








Corporate Social Contribution / Donation: Planting Trees in Thailand. 4,000 acres planted (how many die), 40,000 acres deforested / year.

Thai Airways International (THAI) has set up a committee to investigate one of its pilots after he refused to allow three MPs from the People Power party (PPP) to board his aircraft yesterday. THAI vice-president Norahuch Ployai said captain Jakri Pongsiri had already been suspended until the outcome of the disciplinary investigation, which is expected to be completed next week. He said THAI had a policy of being politics-free and ensuring fair service. "Of course his action affects our image in the eyes of the public," Flight Officer Norahuch said. He described the incident as "unusual".


